# Campbell County dedicates school

Campbell County's newest school, Crossroads Elementary, welcomed Gov. Ernie Fletcher to its grand opening and dedication Sunday, Sept. 23.

"Few things can rival the opening of a school," said Fletcher. "This is a celebration of opportunity. Hundreds of futures will be influenced here. Hundreds of young minds will be influenced in this building every day."

The new school, taking the name the Coyotes, is near the Cold Spring Crossing Shopping Center.

"Those who have toured the school agree that it's a school to be proud of," said Anthony Strong, superintendent of Campbell County Schools. "It's a place that will increase student achievement, add to the quality of life in our community, and instill a sense of pride."

The brick school's interior is decorated in red and white. A clock tower stands over the front doors. Just inside the doors, a large library greets the students.

Strong said the school, currently with approximately 550 students, will reach capacity within the next 5-10 years.

"This small investment will have huge future returns," said Strong.
